What is a Reflection Activity?

A **Reflection Activity** is a simple, engaging, and developmentally appropriate exercise designed to help young children summarize and process what they have just learned. These activities strengthen connections to new and emerging concepts while also supporting language development.

To be most effective, the activity should match the child's developmental level, with a parent or caregiver providing guidance throughout the reflection process. Reflection activities should always be a **positive and enriching experience**, reinforcing learning in a way that is both meaningful and enjoyable.
