# HOW TO USE THIS *Devotional*

SIMPLE STEPS FOR A MEANINGFUL  
EASTER JOURNEY

## JUST A FRIENDLY NOTE

### *Parents:*

You don't need special training, perfect words, or extra time to use this devotional well. This 3-day Easter devotional was created to help you slow down and walk through the story of Easter together—simply and meaningfully.

Whether you read it all at once or take your time each day, what matters most is being present, talking together, and creating space for God's truth to take root in your child's heart.

There's no pressure to do everything—just begin where you are.

*You are planting seeds that matter.*

## QUICK START GUIDE:



**Day 1** – Good Friday: The Greatest Love

**Day 2** – Saturday: Waiting & Trusting

**Day 3** – Easter Sunday: He Is Risen

### **Each day includes a few simple parts:**

#### **1. Read Together**

Read the short devotional aloud. Keep it relaxed—there's no rush.

#### **2. Talk About It**

Use the reflection question to gently start a conversation. There are no “right” answers.

#### **3. Pray Simply**

Say the prayer together or in your own words. Even a short, heartfelt prayer is meaningful.

#### **4. Do (Optional Activity)**

Complete the simple activity if it fits your time and energy.

*These small, simple moments often leave the biggest impact.*

# Devotional

Scripture: “Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!” – John 12:13

**Theme:** Jesus’ sacrifice

**Focus:** Love, forgiveness, surrender

## Devotional:

Today we remember the day Jesus gave His life for us. It was a sad and heavy day, but also the greatest act of love the world has ever known. Even while He was on the cross, Jesus chose to forgive.

He didn’t have to—but He did it because He loves us so much.



## FAMILY REFLECTION:

Jesus loves you so much that He chose the cross.  
That love is for you—every single day.

How does it make you feel to know Jesus loves you this much?

*Side Note for Parents:*

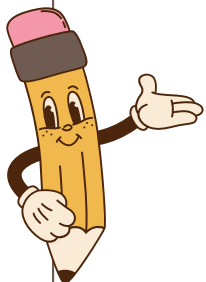
Help your child connect this prayer to something real in their life—something they've been forgiven for or a moment they experienced grace.

# Devotional

### Scripture:

“Wait for the Lord; be strong and take heart and wait for the Lord.” – Psalm 27:14

**Theme:** Waiting

**Focus:** Trust, patience, faith

### Devotional:

This was the quiet day.

Jesus’ friends were sad and confused. They didn’t understand what was happening, and it felt like everything was over.

But even in the silence... God was still working.

Sometimes we have days like that too—when we don’t understand and nothing seems to be changing. But just like this day, it doesn’t mean God isn’t at work.



## FAMILY REFLECTION:

Even when things feel quiet or uncertain, God is still working.

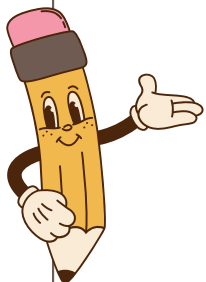

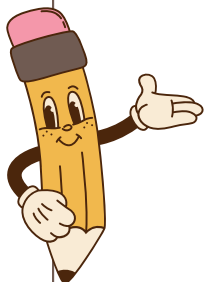

- What are you thankful for today?

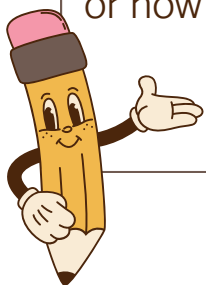
## JOURNAL
